

## James R. "Rick" Dunagan



Rick Dunagan served one tour with the 4<sup>th</sup> Platoon of the 101<sup>st</sup> RRC in 1968-1969 and another with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Platoon, in 1970-1971.

At Fort Devens, Rick drove an older British sports car, perhaps an Austin Healey, with a 289 cid Ford Mustang engine literally squeezed into it. After the army, he was instrumental in forming a motorcycle club in Spartanburg, SC.

Rick, who was born in 1947, passed away in 1984, at age 36. He is interred in Little Mountain Baptist Church Cemetery, in Inman, SC.
