


John L. Foster



John arrived in Nha Trang in late 1967, assigned to HHC, 313th RRBn, where he stayed until transferring to the 2nd Platoon, 101st RRC, also in Nha Trang. He left Vietnam in September 1970 when his request to further extend his tour was denied. It is believed that he never took a special leave with his extensions, although

he did take 7 days leave once and spent it in Nha Trang.

Shortly after John's departure from Vietnam, we received word that he had stopped on the way home to pick up his motorcycle and had a fatal accident a block short of arriving home. John was 21 years old. He is interred in Mount Vernon Memorial Park in Fair Oaks, CA.
