


Edward “Ed” Lileikis



Ed Lileikis moved from the 404th RRD, supporting the 82nd Airborne, on LZ English in Bong Son, to the 2nd platoon, 101st RRC, in November 1969. This is when the COMSEC mission in Vietnam was moved from the direct support units to the 101st. The following month, all E-4s in the 2nd Platoon in Nha Trang were promoted to E-5. All, that is, except for Ed who lacked one month of being eligible.

He continued to serve in the 2nd Platoon until 1971.
