

Michael Thomas Milnamow, 76, of Valrico, Florida died on August 18, 2019 surrounded by his wife of 40 years and two daughters.

Michael was born on December 3, 1942, in Chicago, Illinois to Eugene and Helen Milnamow. He grew up in Glen Ellyn, Illinois and graduated from Ripon College, Wisconsin with a degree in Economics in 1964.
