Robert S. Virgin, 61, of Jefferson [PA], went to be with the Lord Saturday, July 3, 2010, in his home.

He was born May 7, 1949, in Waynesburg, a son of Lucille Scott Virgin Policz of Jefferson and the late Robert S. Virgin.

Mr. Virgin was a 1967 graduate of Jefferson-Morgan High School. He earned an associate degree from the University of the State of New York and a bachelor's degree in education from California University of Pennsylvania.
