

## Robert David (Dave) “Wags” Wagner



Dave Wagner began his extended tour of Vietnam with the 374<sup>th</sup> RRC, in An Khe, supporting the 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division. In November 1969, with the reorganization of the COMSEC mission, he transferred into the 2<sup>nd</sup> Platoon of the 101<sup>st</sup> RRC, where he quickly established his presence. To Dave, everyone was a 'Nug' (new guy), even the puppy he adopted. He returned to the states and civilian life in 1971.

Dave, born in 1948, passed away in 2006 at the age of 58, reportedly of complications attributed to his exposure to Agent Orange in Vietnam. He is interred in the George Washington Memorial Park and Mausoleum in Plymouth Meeting, PA.
